

OXON & NORTH BUCKS COUNTIES A.S.A. PRESS RELEASE



Oxon and North Bucks County Swimming Association hosted the annual Kingerlee Trophy at Stantonbury Campus and Leisure Centre. The trophy, for swimmers aged 10 to 13 years, was challenged by four counties; Warwickshire, Bedfordshire, Leicestershire and the hosts. A record number of O&NB swimmers were awarded county colours in recognition of their first county swims. Matthew Masters and Emily Young, both of CMKSC, received county colours for a third swim.

In the 13 years age group 100m events, Matthew Masters won both the backstroke and freestyle, Guy Giles (Wantage) won the butterfly and Adam Colling (Witney) finished second in the breaststroke. Emma Joyce (CMK) won the fly with Rebecca Marshall (CMK) and Anna Evison (Maxwell) finishing second respectively in the back and breaststroke events.

12 years old Alex Murphy (Didcot) took first place in the breaststroke and Adam Van Lokven (CMK) came second in the fly. Emma Lomas (Oxford) finished second in the breaststroke as did Jocelyn Ulyett (CMK) in the freestyle. Charlotte Alsop (Oxford) won the 12 years old girls backstroke.

In the 11 years age group Liam O'Brien (Maxwell) won the freestyle and Elliot Moulder (CMK) came second in the fly. For the girls Lucy Smith (Oxford) finished in second place in the freestyle.

The 10 years age group swam 50m individual events with Aylesbury swimmers Nathaniel Armstrong finishing second in both the backstroke and breaststroke and Katy Willis also taking second place in the girls' freestyle. Maxwell's Leah Picillo came second in the fly.

Success in the relays included the boys' 13 years team of Matt Masters, Adam Colling, Guy Giles and Aaron Lee (Maxwell) winning the 200M Medley and the 12 years girls' team of Grace Youell (Aylesbury), Molly Williamson (Oxford), Heidi Brooke-Little (Witney) and Jocelyn Ulyett winning the 200M freestyle.

With the help of Harry Basterfield, Olivia Law (both Abingdon); Adam Catlin (Bicester); Courtney De Santos (Bletchley); Katie Lee (Buckingham Swans); Imogen Atkinson, Hannah Weetman, Victoria Yu (CMK); Thomas Panton (Kidlington); Bradley Alder, Alfie Bones, Ellie Bunce, Sophie Cliffe, Keiran Coll, Abbie Hayward, Emily Martin, Adam Mayho, Sarah Pritchard, Caitlin Wheatley (Maxwell); Leanne Brooks, Molly Williamson (Oxford) and Jack Cockcroft, Alex Foggett, Callum McLean (Witney), the Oxon and North Bucks Swim team finished in second place overall with 123 points.
